The Nakanoshima Kosetsu Museum of Art is pleased to announce the exhibition “Kosetsu Museum Collection × Wakako Kawakami: Enjoying Ancient Art with Pico & Peeta” as part of our summer program.

The Kosetsu Museum of Art, a public interest incorporated foundation, maintains a collection of ancient art from Japan and East Asia that it utilizes in cultural activities. In recent years, however, we have not had the opportunity to exhibit our collection in a comprehensive manner. Therefore, for this exhibition, we have carefully selected masterpieces from the Museum's collection to present together, so that they can be enjoyed by a wide range of people of all ages. Welcoming visitors to the exhibit are approximately 200 colorful budgies (a species of parrot) of various sizes—fabric sculptures created by contemporary artist Wakako Kawakami. Our aim in this exhibition is to allow visitors to approach the artworks with a childlike sense of wonder. We hope you will enjoy freely engaging in dialogue with the budgies while discovering the allure of East Asian classical art.
